Bois-des-Esprits is home to the finest forest sculptures in Winnipeg. Get a guided tour to Woody, the 3 metre high carved spirit tree that guards the forest and discover over 10 recently completed bird and wood spirit carvings embedded in dead tree stumps. Also, tour other local trails.

Come out for a fun time with Save Our Seine on the trails of the Seine River Greenway's magical forest, the Bois-des-Esprits – Winnipeg's largest contiguous river - bottom and upland forest. Or take a guided walk along the route of a new Seine River trail that will soon be built south of the Southglen Bridge.


