

Here are the Manitoba Liberals' responses to the Walking and Cycling Policy Questionnaire:

- 1) Yes. This fits well within our preventative healthcare strategy. We will make the necessary investments, and pass the necessary legislation to make this a reality.
- 2) The Manitoba Liberal party has committed to giving 1% of the PST to municipalities. This is far more than 17\$ per Manitoban, and it is adequate funding for municipalities to plan, design and construct walking and cycling infrastructure.
- 3) Yes. The Manitoba Liberal party will allocate resources based on use. If 10% of people cite walking and cycling as their primary modes of transportation, at least 10% of provincial government employees in the transportation sector will be dedicated to walking and cycling planning and infrastructure.
